HEALTH REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Listed below are the Rhode Island Department of Health required immunizations that **ALL** children must have written proof of before entering school.

Immunization dates **MUST** include month, day and year.

Please return all forms with registration. No registration will be accepted without complete forms.

DPT: 5 doses

One dose must be after the 4th birthday.

(4 doses are acceptable if the last dose is after the 4th birthday)

If series begun after age 7, then 3 doses of TD are acceptable.

ALL entering grades 7-12 need either a TD or Tdap booster (if it has been 5 years since the last dose).

Polio: 4 doses

All 4 doses may be before age 4

3 doses are acceptable if the last dose is after age 4 and all are OPV or IPV

No requirement if 18 years or older.

MMR: 2 doses

First dose **MUST** be on or after 1st birthday.

Second dose should be between ages 4-6.

Must be a minimum of 4 weeks between 1st and 2nd dose.

Measles only vaccine is not acceptable for one dose.

Hepatitis B: 3 doses

Second dose must be a minimum of 4 weeks after 1st dose.

Third dose must be 4-6 months after 1st dose or a minimum of 8 weeks between 2nd and 3rd dose if in a catch up schedule.

Varicella: 1 dose

Two doses are required if 1st dose given on or after 13th birthday.

Recommended:

HPV: 3 doses for girls ages 9-18

Meningococcal: age 11-12 and at 13-18 if not previously vaccinated.
